Anti-Reproductive Rights Crimes, CCN – 55014: This training program is designed to educate California's first responders on appropriate resources and responses to anti-reproductive rights crimes. The program is based on the POST Guideline "Anti-Reproductive Rights Crimes" and introduces learners to the California Freedom of Access to Clinic and Churches Entrances Act (CA FACE Act). The program uses scenarios, discussion, and subject matter expert interviews to highlight key points throughout the lesson and meets the requirements of 13519.15 for training on this topic.
